GUIDELINES FOR SIDING

Siding must be Royal HAVBB10

Color Sand

Must be horizontal

NO chimney can be covered

NO privacy walls can be covered

NO stucco can be covered – but can be removed and replaced with siding

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR INDIVIDUAL UNITS

Areas that can be sided

Adams: Back wall, garage walls, parapet walls, front walls, NO CHIMNEY

Burnham: Front door area, garage walls, parapet walls, NO CHIMNEY

Clark: Whole house, parapet walls, NO CHIMNEY

Dearborn – to be determined

Evanston: Front door areas, parapet walls, back walls, NO CHIMNEY (whole house, with the exception of garage front, or over existing stone)

All siding installed is the responsibility of the homeowner if repairs are needed. You must engage a contractor. Acacia Association is not responsible for any damage or problems arising from installation of siding on your home.

This responsibility is transferable in the event home ownership is transferred to a new owner.
